戦時下の女学校 Girls' High Schools During the War Time

太平洋戦争中、千葉市内には、県立千葉高等女学校(現県立千葉女子高校)及び千葉淑徳高等女学校(現明徳高校)、そして千葉 女子商業学校(現千葉経済大学附属高校)などの女学校がありました。 戦争が激しくなり、本土空襲が始まると、防空訓練・救護訓練が実施されるなど、銃後を支える生活となりました。 県立千葉高等女学校では、昭和19年には学校そのものが日立航空機の工場となり、授業は停止されました。昭和20年6月10日

と7月7日の空襲で同校の校舎は、同窓会館を除いて全焼しました。

During the Pacific War, there were various girls' high schools in Chiba City, some of which included the Prefectural Chiba Girls' School (currently the Chiba Prefectural Chiba Girls' High School), the Chiba Shukutoku High School for Girls (currently the Chiba Meitoku High School), as well as the Chiba School of Commerce for Girls (currently Chiba Keizai University High School).

As the war raged on and bombings began to occur in Japan, daily life turned into one of supporting the front lines in the form of air defence drills and relief drills. The Prefectural Chiba Girls' School was essentially turned into a factory for Hitachi Aircrafts in the year 1944, and classes were suspended. During the bombings of June 10 and July 7 in the year 1945, everything but the alumni association hall was burnt down.
