

What is a residents' association?



Neighbors and nearby community members can support and assist each other in the event of trouble such as earthquakes. Residents' associations are organizations where residents cooperate on a voluntary basis to provide a safe and comfortable environment for the community.

Residents' associations are involved in projects such as:

Building a safe community

Safety patrols, installation and management of street lights, etc.



Creating a clean and livable community

Management and cleaning of garbage stations, mowing grass and planting flowers on streets and in parks, recycling, etc.



Summer festivals, sports festivals, etc.





Disaster Prevention • Support

Disaster prevention drills, support for senior citizens, etc.

Providing information such as community newsletters, notices from public offices, etc.

Telephone Interpreting Service

A telephone interpreting service is provided by the Chiba City International Association when an interpreter is required for receiving city administration services at the city hall, ward office, etc., or communicating with schools, etc.

Service Hours

Eligible Institutions

The telephone interpreting service can be used for administrative services at the city hall, ward office, health and welfare centers, etc., as well as at municipal elementary and junior high schools, day care centers, etc.

Interpretation involving specialized content such as medical treatment at the hospital, classroom lessons, etc., cannot be provided.

How to use the Telephone Interpreting Service

- (1) Call the Chiba City International Association (TEL 043-245-5750).
- (2) Tell the staff member the phone number you want to call, hang up the phone and wait to be called back.
- (3) The International Association staff will make the call.
- (4) The International Association staff will hear the details of your consultation, convey that to the city administrative staff, and listen to the administrative response. The International Association staff will convey that response to you.
